### Purpose

The CLPS Academic Success Center (ASC) partners with parents to provide services to help all students succeed in our academic program.

### Objectives

#### 1. Parent Coaching & Care

The ASC provides parent care for academic and relational issues which impact the whole child's well-being.

#### 2. Teacher Development

The ASC provides ongoing teacher training in areas related to students who are struggling academically and/or in other areas including diagnosed learning differences, behavioral issues, and executive functioning skills. (Some examples include dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, processing disorders, ADD/ADHD, autism, etc).

#### 3. Student Support

The ASC provides student support using the Response to Intervention (RTI) model. Support may include classroom accommodations for students, small group interventions and individual tutoring and/or therapy for students who meet the criteria for these services.

Tier 1: Classroom Instruction & Support

Tier 2: Small Group Supplemental Instruction & Intervention

Tier 3: Individualized Instruction & Intervention

### Student Support at CLPS

1. Classroom Strategies and/or Accommodations
2. Small Group Sessions
  - Rx Math
  - Rx Reading
3. Individual Instruction
  - Learning Lab for Individual or Small Group Testing
  - Rhythmic Writing
  - Search & Teach Reading Evaluation and Instruction for struggling readers (K-1 grade)
  - Informal Reading Inventory & Reading Intervention Strategies for struggling readers (3-8 grade)
  - National Institute for Learning Development (NILD) Therapy (Individual Therapy)

Small Group Sessions (3-5 students)

Individual Academic Tutoring (2-3 hrs/week)

NILD Therapy (Individual Support & Intervention)

CLPS Search & Teach sessions (Up to 4 sessions)
