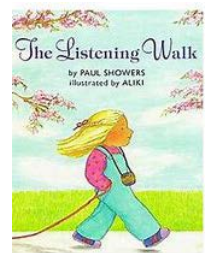

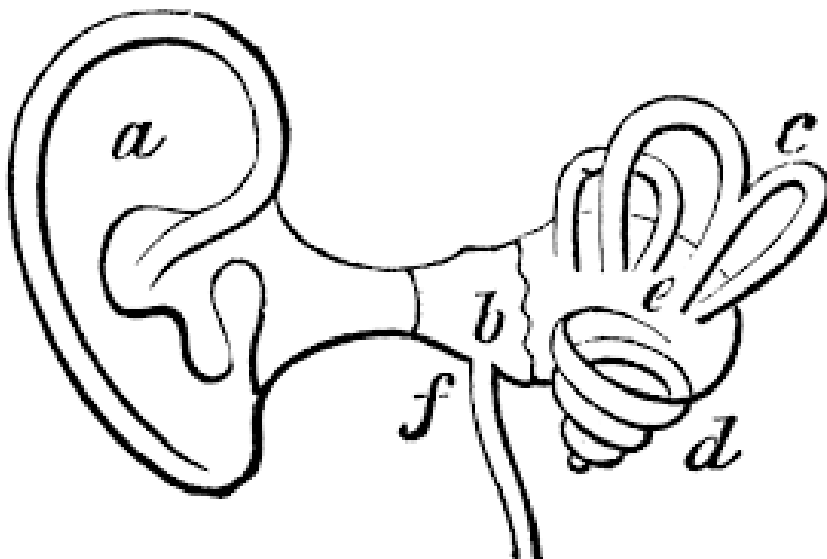
The Listening Walk

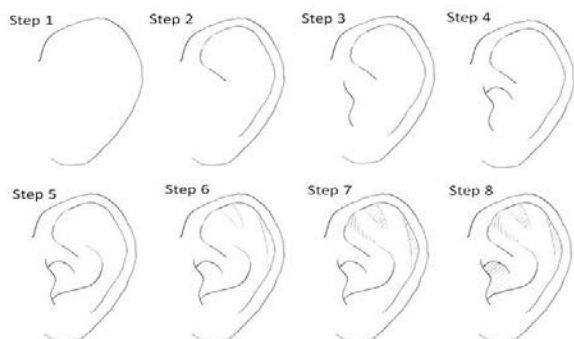

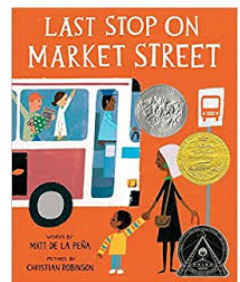

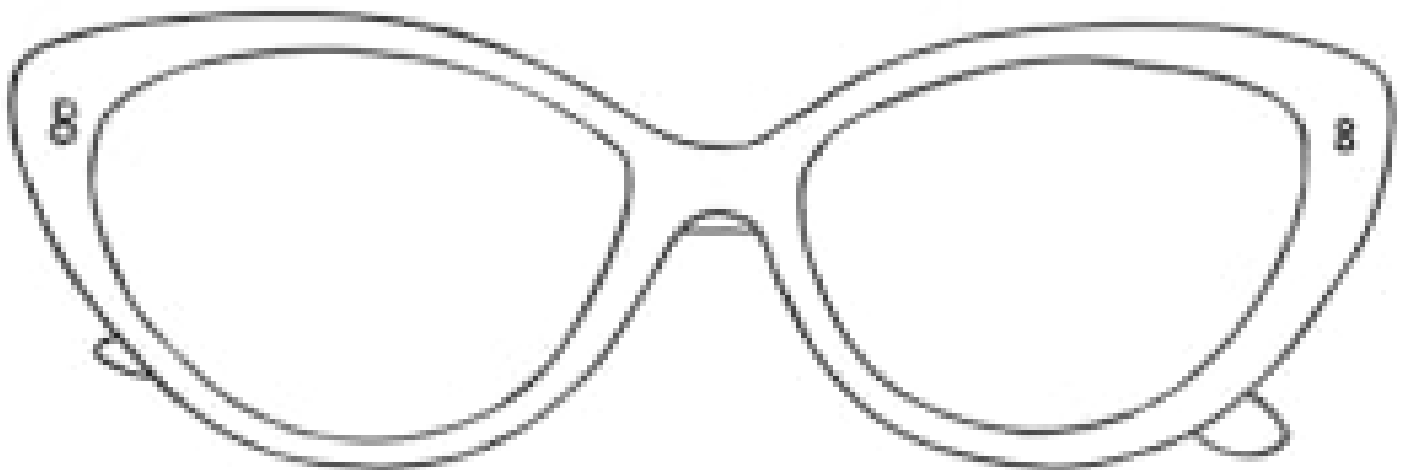
Last Stop on Market Street
