

Drama Class vs. Club

Fall 2022-Spring 2023

Fine Arts Credit

CLPS offers two courses to fulfill the requirements for Fine Arts Credit on High School Transcripts.

Students may choose between Beginning High School Drama and High School Art.

Both courses meet for 1 hour on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with no outside time commitments.

The previous production requirements for Drama has been moved to the CLPS Club Space.

Beginning High School Drama Class

Intended for students wanting to earn their Fine Arts Credit for High School Transcript.

No previous drama experience is required.

There is no outside production expectations beyond a showcase for families or Follies Act.

Students may choose the role of Technical Crew for this production (you don't have to perform on stage).

The class will meet for 1 hour on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays with no outside commitments.

Drama Production Club

Drama Production Club is intended for CLPS students who want to participate in full-length or one act play productions without having to be enrolled in the Drama class for an entire school year.

Drama Production Club

Audition Based

Limited to 8-9 week “seasons”

Production will meet in the “club space” from 3:00-4:00pm.

There will be extended rehearsals in the 2-3 weeks leading up to production.

Drama Production Club- The Benefits

Students do not need to enroll in the drama class to participate in shows (but current drama class students are welcome to audition for club).

Lower fee to participate in a “season”

High School Students will receive an additional 1 hour elective credit on their transcript for fully participating in a club season.

Seasons are designed to have extended rehearsals that do not conflict with Sports Commitments.

- Lower fee for participation
